The University Health Center was established in the year 1428 AH, consisting of two branches, one in Arar and the other in Rafha. The University Health Center benefits from the support and attention of the university administration to provide the highest level of medical care for the university's male and female staff.

The University Health Center provides its therapeutic and preventive services through general and specialized medical clinics, as well as auxiliary medical services such as the laboratory, pharmacy, and radiology, which are supervised by qualified and experienced individuals. Additionally, the University Health Center also seeks to achieve healthcare services aimed at improving performance levels and gaining satisfaction from the center's beneficiaries. It endeavors to modernize and develop in line with the scientific and medical advancements witnessed in our beloved country.

The University Health Center also provides medical reports and medical leaves for eligible university staff and students. It offers its therapeutic and preventive services through general and specialized medical clinics, as well as auxiliary medical services such as the laboratory, pharmacy, and radiology, supervised by qualified and experienced individuals. Furthermore, the University Health Center strives to achieve healthcare services aimed at improving performance levels and gaining satisfaction from the center's beneficiaries. It endeavors to modernize and develop in line with the scientific and medical advancements witnessed in our beloved country. Additionally, the Health Center provides emergency clinics and general medical services at various female colleges such as the Girls Colleges Complex, the Colleges of Science and Business Administration, the College of Economics, and the Community College. It also operates a mobile clinic on the male campus in collaboration with the National Committee for Tobacco Control to assist those wishing to quit smoking. Moreover, the Health Center participates in sports activities provided by the University's Student Affairs Deanship, including football, volleyball, swimming, athletics, and more. Additionally, the Health Center possesses a medical ambulance and a mobile medical caravan to provide medical services in remote areas and neighboring villages. The second branch of the Health Center is located in the city of Rafha, serving male and female students and university staff in the colleges located there. This branch consists of five clinics: internal medicine, dentistry, obstetrics and gynecology, and two general clinics.

The target audience for the University Health Center services:

- 1. Male and female university students at the undergraduate and graduate levels.
- 2. Faculty members and their families.
- 3. University staff and their families.
- 4. Family members dependent on university affiliates, including:
- Parents (father and mother).

- Spouse.
- Children.

Medical Services:

The health center provides its diagnostic and preventive services through general and specialized medical clinics, in addition to supporting medical services, as follows:

- Medical examination for new male and female students, as well as newly appointed staff.
- Medical examination for referrals, disease diagnosis, monitoring acute and chronic diseases,
 and determining the best treatment methods.
- Disease diagnosis through laboratory tests and radiography.
- Pregnancy monitoring at the obstetrics and gynecology clinic.
- Implementation of health education programs for chronic diseases, as well as preventive programs for gum and dental diseases by nursing doctors and those involved in treatment.
- Conducting ongoing cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) courses for healthcare
 practitioners and university staff nominated through the accredited CPR center by the Saudi
 Heart Association.
- Referring complicated medical cases to Ministry of Health hospitals in coordination with them.
- Preparation of medical reports and approval of medical reports issued by Ministry of Health hospitals.
- Providing periodic awareness programs within the health center and university campus coinciding with international health days to increase awareness among students and university staff.

Women's and Maternity Clinic

- Monitoring women during pregnancy through ultrasound examination.
- Monitoring ovulation through ultrasound.
- Diagnosis and treatment of gynecological diseases.
- Diagnosis of breast diseases and referral of cases such as breast masses to specialized hospitals.
- Providing awareness to enhance the health of mothers and fetuses.
- Providing medical consultations for chronic diseases associated with pregnancy.
- Providing counseling and prescribing family planning methods.

• Educating and treating girls with menstrual disorders.
