Male and female students from Northern Border Schools continued their visits to the exhibition held in Arar when Environment Week under the slogan Our environment is our responsibility, which falls on the first week of the spring semester every year.

Participating parties in the “Our Environment, Our Responsibility” exhibition, organized by the branch of the Ministry of Environment, Water and Agriculture in the region in the city of Arar, included (Civil Defense, Border Guard in the Northern Border Region, Human Rights Commission branch, Education Department, Agricultural Development Fund, Social Development Bank, Saudi Electricity Company, The Northern Border Journalists Association, the Northern College of Nursing, the Housing House Association, and many private sector entities).

The activities, which last for a week, aim to raise the level of environmental awareness among all segments of society and various sectors, enhance environmental awareness among members of society, and stimulate good habits and behaviors that encourage the protection and care of the environment at all levels and entities and those interested in the cultural environmental field.

The Ecology and Sustainable Development course introduces students to the fundamental principles of sustainable development, sustainability, the economic, social, and environmental dimensions of sustainability. Additionally, the course covers the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).

On Tuesday, 10/6/1441 AH, His Excellency the Vice Rector for Academic Affairs, Dr. Firas bin Mohammed Al-Madani, inaugurated a series of student clubs at the College of Science, specializing in environment, computing, chemistry, physics, and mathematics. The inauguration ceremony took place at the College of Science Theater in the university city of Arar, in the presence of His Excellency the Dean of the College of Science, Dr. Ahmed bin Subeih Al-Sharari, the Vice Dean, Dr. Fawaz bin Haji Al-Enzi, along with department heads, faculty members, and students. The event was also broadcast via video conferencing to the women's section of the college.

The student clubs aim to align with the evolving needs of the educational process and Saudi Vision 2030 by refining and developing students' skills, fostering connections among them, encouraging initiative and competition, and promoting self-development and the acquisition of new competencies. Additionally, the clubs provide a platform for students to explore practical and extracurricular skills while facilitating knowledge exchange.

During the event, department heads overseeing mathematics, computing, environment, chemistry, and physics clubs presented the vision, mission, and objectives of these student organizations. Club leaders from the student body further explained the structure, responsibilities, and diverse activities of the clubs, which include seminars, workshops, scientific visits, and initiatives to promote a culture of innovation. The clubs also support students academically and personally while encouraging participation in local, regional, and international competitions. The students expressed their gratitude

to the University President for approving the establishment of these diverse clubs, which serve to enrich the academic experience at the College of Science.
