Northern Border University Concludes the Mawhiba Academic Enrichment Program



Northern Border University concluded the **Mawhiba Academic Enrichment Program** for talented male and female students, organized by the University's Talent Academy in partnership with the King Abdulaziz and His Companions Foundation for Giftedness and Creativity (Mawhiba) and sponsored by **Saudi Arabian Mining Company (Ma'aden)**. The ceremony was held at the College of Science Theater in the university city of Arar.

The program, which took place from 5/1/1445 to 23/1/1445 Hijri (23-07-2023 to 10-08-2023), aimed to expand students' intellectual and cognitive horizons and open new avenues for their development. This was achieved by providing an enriching academic environment where students could interact with their peers in the same age group, engage in scientific activities under the supervision of experts, and showcase their creative abilities.
